DELTA FARMS WATER CONTROL DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES OCTOBER 17, 2023

A. CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Board Meeting of October 17, 2023, of the Delta Farms Water Control District ("District"), was called to order at 8:00 a.m. in the offices of Carter Associates located at 1708 12st Street, Vero Beach, Florida 32960.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Proof of publication was presented that showed notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Indian River Press Journal* on October 5, 2023, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Sakuma stated that the attendance of Supervisors Rusty Banack, Tim Dooley and Brian Randolph constituted a quorum and it was in order for the meeting to proceed.

Also in attendance were: District Manager Frank Sakuma of Special District Services, Inc. and District Engineer Clint Rahjes P.E. of Carter Associates.

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO AGENDA

The following additions to the agenda were authorized by the Board:

- Status of Kromhout conveyance (Old Business);
- Ross Simon Shed (New Business);
- Flap Gate Discussion (New Business);
- Pump Stations Sand Blast and Paint (New Business).

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

There were no comments from the public.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. August 15, 2023, Regular Board Meeting and Public Hearing

The August 15, 2023, Regular Board Meeting and Public Hearing minutes were approved on a **motion** made by Mr. Dooley, seconded by Mr. Banack and the **motion** passed unanimously.

G. REPORTS

1. Treasurer

Mr. Banack discussed the Board financial data provided in the Board package. After Board discussion he asked for copies of the engineering invoices so he could review them against the financials. After further discussion, the October 17th Treasurer's Report was approved on a **motion** made by Mr. Dooley, seconded by Mr. Randolph and the **motion** passed unanimously.

2. Engineer

Mr. Rahjes advised the Board that the written Engineer's Report would be distributed via email. He answered several Board questions. After further discussion, the October 17th Engineer's Report was approved on a **motion** made by Mr. Banack, seconded by Mr. Dooley and the **motion** passed unanimously.

3. Attorney

There was no Attorney Report at this time.

4. Chairman

There was no Chairman Report at this time.

H. OLD BUSINESS

1. Update on Colella FPL Permit

Ms. Cynthia Colella advised the Board that negotiations with Mr. Kromhout were continuing, and no resolution had been finalized to allow power to her property.

2. Update on Kromhout Transfer (Driveway Encroachment)

The Board discussed the ongoing process of transferring District property on which Mr. Kromhout's driveway exists. Consensus was that the transfer should only occur once the FPL permit issues related to Ms. Colella were resolved.

I. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Resolution No. 2023-06 – Approving a Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Amended Budget

Mr. Sakuma presented Resolution No. 2023-06, entitled:

RESOLUTION 2023-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE DELTA FARMS WATER CONTROL DISTRICT AUTHORIZING AND ADOPTING AN AMENDED FINAL FISCAL YEAR 2022/2023 BUDGET, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 197, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

After Board discussion, a **motion** was made by Mr. Dooley, seconded by Mr. Banack and passed unanimously adopting Resolution 2023-06, as presented.

2. Discussion of Front Gate - Cynthia Colella

Ms. Colella asked the Board if she could install a "gate handler" on the existing gate, or have a new gate installed with a handler. Board consensus was to allow the installation, provided at least 16' minimum width, either with a single or double gate design.

3. Discussion of Ross Simon – Shed

Mr. Rahjes advised the Board that Mr. Simon was asking if the Board would consider allowing a 12'X12' shed on District property. The Board determined that if the shed were installed completely on private property, then no action would be required by the District. If the shed were to be installed on District property, then a permit application would be required. The Board asked that District Engineer Tyler Spencer reach out to Mr. Simon to determine if a permit application is required.

4. Flap Gate Discussion

Mr. Randolph led a discussion with the Board on work that needed to be done on one of the flap gates in the reservoir, which may cost about \$17,000. He advised that once he received the quote it would be shared with the Supervisors.

5. Pump Stations – Sand Blast and Paint

Mr. Banack advised of Station "A" sand blast and painting work being done, which will cost about \$3,000. The Board agreed that Stations "B" and "C" should be evaluated and also sand blasted and painted if needed.

J. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

There were no further Administrative Matters.

K. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

There were no further comments from the Board.

L. ADJOURNMENT
